



CALL FOR PROJECTS FOR 2 YOUNG PHOTOGRAPHERS

Creative residency «Photography & Sciences» from 1st march to 30th april 2023 in Toulouse

The 1+2 Residency is a festival of creative residencies combining photography and sciences, based in Toulouse, with a European vocation. Supported in its research by academic (Université fédérale de Toulouse) and scientific (CNRS Occitanie Ouest, Muséum de Toulouse) institutions and researchers based in Toulouse and its metropolis, as well as in Occitanie, each resident creates a personal and original work. He/She is also accompanied by a godparent belonging to either photography or sciences field. By combining photography and sciences, the 1+2 Residency produces, enhances and promotes an author photography in close connection with an exceptional scientific heritage in the region.

The result of this creative process will be presented in october and november 2023 in the form of a group exhibition in Toulouse. An inaugural week is organized with several highlights including the «National Symposium - Photography & Sciences» in which photographers, scientists, godparent, journalists and the general public are exchanging views during several thematic round tables. The 1+2 Residency thus works so that this sharing of knowledge creates a common societal reflection in a collective dynamic involving all the audiences.

THE TOULOUSE 1+2 RESIDENCY «Photography & Sciences»

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The call for projects aims to select two young photographers for the 2023 edition of 1+2 Residency Toulouse "Photography & Sciences". No age limit is required.

All contemporary photographic writings are concerned.

> SUPPORTED BY THE 1+2 RESIDENCY

- A round trip (home-Toulouse).
- Collective housing for two months (1st march 30th april).
- Free public transport (metro & bus) in the Toulouse agglomeration.
- The necessary supplies for the creation during the residency up to a maximum of 500 euros.
- A total remuneration of 2400 euros for two months (750 euros /month and 15 euros per-diem for each day of effective presence in Toulouse).
- The production of an exhibition up to a maximum of 2000 euros. The works created are exhibited and a maximum of 3 of them are added to the 1+2 Residency's collection of works, which provides a lump-sum remuneration for the display of this collection in future individual and/or group exhibitions. The original negatives and/or digital files remain the property of the author.
- The collection of works may be exhibited or reproduced solely for the promotion of the 1+2 Residency.
- The publication of a book, as part of the residency's annual box set, by Éditions Filigranes.
- Each winner receives 30 individual books.
- A technical team to support each winner.
- The 1+2 Residency undertakes to use the images provided by the two laureates only for the purpose of promoting the program. It undertakes to contact each laureate to obtain his/her permission and to agree on the conditions of copyright in the event that the images may be used beyond this framework.

> COMMITMENTS OF THE WINNER

No participation fee is required.

The 6 pre-selected candidates will be submitted to a 45-minute oral interview before a final jury and in public. This can be done remotely or face-to-face (preferable) in Toulouse.

- Each winner undertakes to be present during the two-month residency in Toulouse and at several events organized in 2023 in Toulouse, Paris and Arles.
- The winner certifies and guarantees that the works are original creations within the meaning of French law on Intellectual Property and that they are not the counterfeiting of protected works.
- The photographer certifies and guarantees that third parties, in particular persons who may appear on the works, or the authors and beneficiaries of works reproduced on those of the photographer, have given him/her their authorisation for the reproduction and representation of their images or their works.
- In order to promote their work and the 1+2 Residency, the winners grant the 1+2 Residency the right to disseminate excerpts of their work without financial compensation for the producers and the authors (television, internet, programs, posters, flyers...). This authorisation also applies to all publications or events related to the 1+2 Residency.
- Participation in a round table discussion at the residency's annual symposium (october 2023).
- Each winner has to be attentive to mention «1+2 Residency, Toulouse, 2023» in all publications or events related to the 1+2 Residency.
- Compliance with all articles of the agreement established with the 1+2 Residency.

Registration implies that the candidate accepts the terms and conditions set out above.

Deadline for receipt of applications: SUNDAY 11 SEPTEMBER 2022 AT 07:00 PM

The future winners will be selected on the basis of the quality of their previous work, but above all on the relevance of the project proposed in Toulouse, on the theme of «Photography & Sciences».

The selection of the two young photographers for the 2023 edition will be made in two phases. Alongside Philippe Guionie (director of the 1+2 Residency), the pre-selection jury and the final jury will be composed of personalities from the institutional, photographic and scientific worlds, as well as representatives of the specialist press.

The decision of the selection panel will be sovereign and unappealable.

- PRE-SELECTION JURY: 24 September 2022 (6 applications will be selected).
- FINAL JURY (in public): 16 October 2022 (45-minute oral interview).

THE APPLICATION FORM MUST INCLUDE:

- Biography and CV,
- A selection of photographic works (1 or 2 coherent series of 20 images maximum),
- A text presenting the artistic approach (2000 characters maximum),
- A detailed note of intent, describing the stages and perspectives of the «Photography & Sciences» project to be carried out in the Toulouse area in collaboration with the desired scientific partners (CNRS Occitanie Ouest laboratories, universities, Cité de l'espace, etc.). *Warning : do not contact the scientists beforehand.*
